SUPPORT GROUPS

Board of Directors

The Board of Directors manages all affairs of Business Professionals of America and is elected by the corporate body. Every sector of the organization (state supervisors, business, local advisors, and divisions) is represented on the Board. The Board meets at least twice annually. Members may serve no more than two consecutive three-year terms.

National Business Advisory Council (NBAC)

NBAC serves as the liaison between business and industry and the Board of Directors. Members are selected from supportive corporations and are appointed by the Board of Directors.

Classroom Educators Advisory Council (CEAC)

CEAC serves as the liaison between the local advisor and the Board of Directors. CEAC membership consists of one active classroom educator representative from each of the secondary and post-secondary divisions from each affiliated state. One official meeting is held annually. Members may serve no more than two consecutive three-year terms.

State Association Advisory Council (SAAC)

SAAC serves as a liaison between the state associations and the Board of Directors; its function is to make recommendations regarding new and existing programs that affect the state organizations.
